WELCOME TO THE BARRY ROBINSON CENTER SCHOOL!



Barry Robinson Center (BRC) education is committed to recognizing the individual strengths and potential of each student. Our objective is to do our best at meeting each student's specific educational needs and equip them with the skills to keep up academically in a nurturing, educational environment. Once admitted, we prioritize communication with each student's home school by ensuring we request all academic records (i.e., transcripts, attendance, educational testing, IEP/504, Immunization, and disciplinary records).

We aim to directly align coursework requirements for students from various educational backgrounds and geographical locations to our curriculum. BRC education provides comprehensive academic instruction in Mathematics, Language Arts/English, Science, and Social Studies. Art is provided by a licensed art teacher and Physical Education is provided by a licensed P.E. teacher. AP courses are not currently provided via direct instruction or any virtual platform that The Barry Robinson Center School offers.

The Barry Robinson Center School offers a comprehensive educational approach tailored to meet the diverse needs of students across various academic and geographic backgrounds. Our educational model is characterized by a hybrid approach, combining traditional classroom instruction at BRC campus with access to accredited online platforms such as Edgenuity/Edgenuity SIS. our curriculum incorporates nationally Additionally, recognized online programs, including IXL and Khan Academy. These virtual resources serve as valuable supplements, enriching the learning experience and of students' facilitating the monitoring academic advancement.





ASSESSMENTS

The Barry Robinson Center School has the capability to test each student, (unless previously tested within a 1-year time frame), by administering The Woodcock-Johnson IV Tests of Achievement Standard Battery and the Woodcock-Johnson Extended Battery Tests of Oral Language when indicated.

Additional testing is conducted to establish a baseline, benchmark, and cumulative result that allows residents and families to track academic progress.

Virginia students can participate in their homeschool's Standards of Learning (SOLs) and Growth Assessments during their stay with us, if applicable for their grade level requirements. In our regular communication with the student's LEA (Local Education Agency), we request testing materials, administer all required assessments, and promptly send them back to the LEA for review.
